


How To Enter The Payment ID through Evolve

1. Log on to <https://evolve.elsevier.com>
2. Click 'My Evolve' and then click 'Student Access'

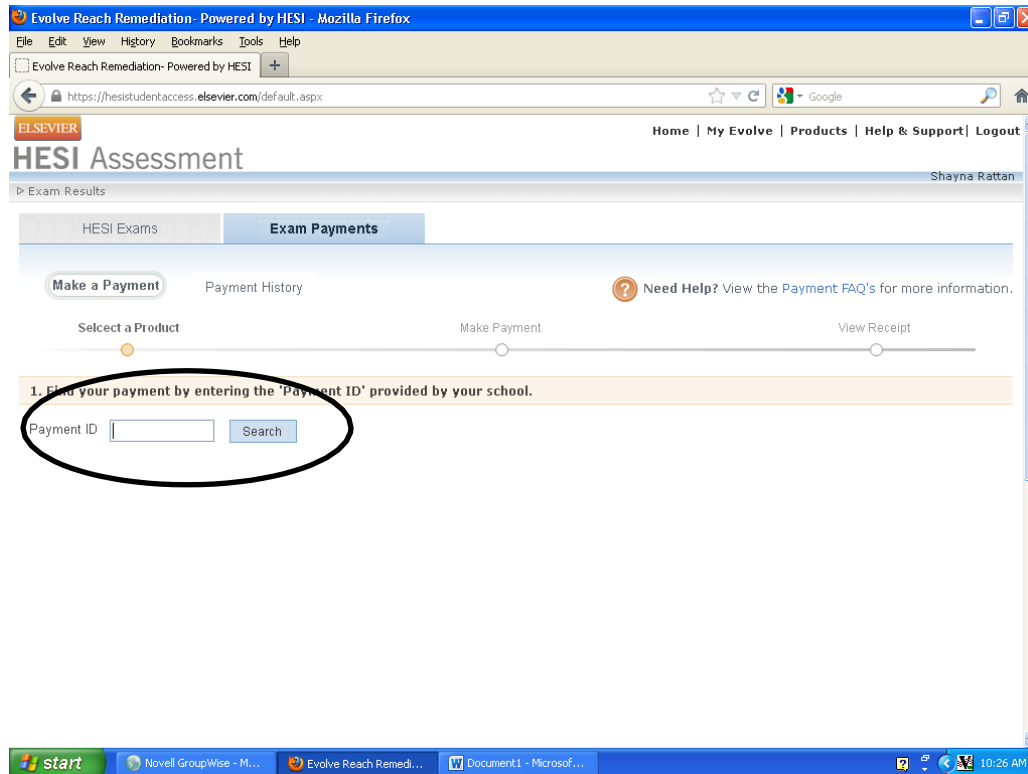
