

RESOLUTION
CANVASSING RETURNS
AND
DECLARING ELECTION RESULTS
OF THE
MAY 5, 2018 TRUSTEE ELECTION

WHEREAS, an election was held within Dallas County on May 5, 2018 to elect one (1) member of the Board of Trustees in District 7; and

WHEREAS, the returns and accompanying records of the election have been delivered to the Chair and presiding officer of the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, Section 67.002(a)(2), Election Code, requires the Board of Trustees to canvass the final returns of the election and Section 67.003(b), Election Code, requires the canvass not earlier than the third day nor later than the eleventh day after election day; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, after review and examination of the returns of the election, is of the opinion that the returns are in all respects proper and legal; and

WHEREAS, it appears from the records maintained by the Dallas County Elections Department that the votes cast in Trustee District 7 are as shown on the tabulation of votes attached hereto and incorporated herein; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF DALLAS COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT:

Section 1. That the returns of the trustee election held on May 5, 2018 for Trustee District 7, are canvassed and approved.

Section 2. That the person who is listed below with the most votes is declared elected, unless challenged as permitted by law or unless a runoff is indicated, as a member of the Board of Trustees for District 7, subject to his/her further qualifications as provided by law:

Section 3. That after the canvass of votes by the Board and completion of election certification, the Vice Chair of the Board of Trustees shall promptly prepare and issue to the person with the most votes, named in Section 2. of this resolution, and to Joseph Larry Williams, who was declared elected to the Board of Trustees, District 1, on March 6, 2018, a Certificate of Election, and after these persons make the required statement disavowing bribery which is filed with the Secretary to the Board of Trustees and take the required oath of office, these persons shall occupy their respective districts as members of the Board of Trustees of Dallas County Community College District in Districts 7 and 1, and are entitled to serve for a period of six years.

Section 4. That this resolution is effective upon adoption by the Board of Trustees of Dallas County Community College District.
